For March 2026 General Fund Income Received \$15,440.73

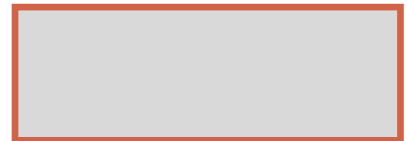
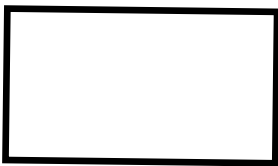
For March, 2026 General Fund Actual Expenses \$20,750.20

Becoming “Greener”

The Worship and Music Committee is encouraging everyone to move toward more sustainable approach in activities here at Waldport Presbyterian, as well as in their own homes. By making small changes in the way we do things, better practices soon become better habits.

Now that the Guild Room has become more the Sunday social center, below are some small changes that we encourage.

Bring your own coffee cup to leave in the Guild Room from week to week. There’s a marker for you to put your initials on the bottom. After using it, wash it out and set it upside down on the cup cart. This will lead to less paper cup waste, as well as a money saver for the church. There will still be paper cups available for those who have forgotten and for guests.

The Guild Room now has 3 bins with instructions. By putting the correct items in each, we’ll be decreasing the amount of trash going to the landfill and greening the earth.

COMPOSTABLES

This bin is for FOOD, NAPKINS, PAPER PLATES (PLAIN), PAPER CUPS, PAPER TOWELS, TEA BAGS, COFFEE GROUNDS & FILTERS, EGG SHELLS.

We can put all of these compostables into the yard debris bin because Dahl’s is now transporting the yard debris and compostables to Pacific Region Compost north of Corvallis. This is a large composting facility where hotter composting temperatures allow the processing of much more than in a home composting bin.

RECYCLE

This bin is for everything you put into your home recycling bin. PAPER, CARDBOARD, RINSED ALUMINUM CANS, AND ALUMINUM FOIL, RINSED PLASTIC BOTTLES WITH A NECK.

TRASH

This bin is for trash. KLEENEX TISSUES, PLASTIC WRAP, PLASTIC PACKAGING (INCLUDING CLEAR CONTAINERS LIKE CAKES COME IN), PAPER PLATES WITH PLASTIC COATING (FLOWER DESIGNS ON THEM, ALL NON-COMPOSTABLES, ALL NON-RECYCLABLES.

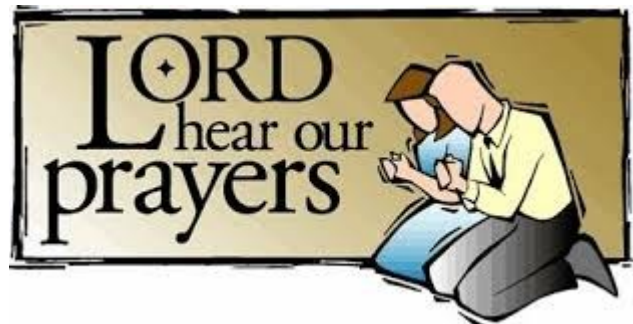
