UMCOR - Cleaning Buckets

We have donated cleaning buckets, ready to be filled, to take to Sager Brown when our Missions Team goes the first Monday in September. A display is set up in the Gathering Place with notes and hints to help you make the correct purchases. A list is available in the gathering area to take with you to the store. Most things can be found at the Dollar Tree, other dollar stores or Walmart. If you would like to bring your purchased supplies to the church, we will gladly pack the bucket for you.

If you have any questions about the items that go in a cleaning bucket, you can ask Nancy Crews or Debbie Young for clarifications.

Hints: NO Cellulose sponges (they dry out when out of the packaging and cause mold inside of a bucket); NO Brillo or SOS scrub pads (they will cause mold also); scrub brushes must have a handle (no toilet brushes); put the 50 clothespins in a Ziploc type bag and indicate the count; also rubber band the trash bags (33-45 gallon) and indicate the count; the liquids to be included should be the minimum amount requested but can be a little more as long as they fit in the bucket.
