Scriptural and Musical Responses
Holy Week, April 1, 2021

Opening Prayer: (#284 UMH) “Almighty God, graciously behold this your family, for whom our Lord Jesus Christ was willing to be betrayed into the hands of sinners, and to suffer death upon the cross; who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, One God, for ever and ever. Amen.”

Musical Response: #166 “All Praise to Thee, for Thou, O King Divine”

Last Word: “My God, My God, Why Have You Forsaken Me?” (Matthew 27:46)

Scriptural Response: “God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble...Be still, and know that I am God!” (Psalm 46:1, 10)

Musical Response: “Be Still My Soul”

Last Word: “Father Forgive Them; For They Don’t Know What They Are Doing.” (Luke 23:34)

Scriptural Response: Forgive us our sins, as we have forgiven those who sin against us. (Matthew 6:12)

Musical Response: #287 “O Love Divine What Hast Thou Done”

Last Word: “Today You Will Be With Me In Paradise” (Luke 23:43)

Scriptural Response: “In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am. (John 14:2-3)

Musical Response: “Soon”

Last Word: “Woman, Here Is Your Son...Here Is Your Mother.” (John 19:26-27)

Scriptural Response: “We love because he first loved us.” (1 John 4:19)

Musical Response: “Jesus Loves Me”

Last Word: “I Am Thirsty” (John 19:28)

Scriptural Response: “And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of a father’s only son, full of grace and truth.” (John 1:14)

Musical Response: #301 “Jesus Keep Me Near the Cross”

Last Word: “Father, Into Your Hands I Commend My Spirit” (Luke 23:46)

Scriptural Response: “You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.” (Mark 12:30)

Musical Response: #292 “What Wondrous Love Is This”

Last Word: “It Is Finished” (John 19:30)

Scriptural Response: “I tell you the truth, when you did it to one of the least of these my brothers and sisters, you were doing it to me!” (Matthew 25:40)
