If you look at the "Who We Are" page of our website, we talk about three things we value here. As I discerned my call to ministry, I saw myself in a place where the entire person was being fed, nurtured, & ministered to. Spiritual, physical, mental, and emotional needs were being met. I believe that is happening here. This is just the beginning of what God can do through us.

I wanted to take a minute and highlight a mission opportunity that you can participate in: Wesley House. Dave Schultz, the director, and I are close friends from previous appointments when we did mission trips together. Anything that Dave has a passion for is kingdom work that I want us to be a part of. For those that have been donating non-perishable food items for their pantry each month-thank you! I would, however, love to see that increase 5-fold! Remember that the basket in front of the baptismal font is there for us to drop those donations as an expression of our response to God's provision in our lives. They currently have a volunteer opportunity that I also want to highlight. Each Wednesday, they hand out about 300 bags of food to those in need of groceries; it's a vital ministry that has exploded in volume in the last two years. This food distribution happens each Wednesday 12:30-4pm. For the month of October, the Wesley House is looking for volunteers to help direct traffic, speak with families, hand out bags of food, and other related activities. Although the event runs over an entire afternoon, any time you could spend helping with that event would be wonderful. We need each one of you to help us be the hands and feet of Christ! As we look forward as a church, I invite you to continue to think about how we can carry the mission of Christ forward-whether individually or as a church. Let's find ways to be the hands and feet of Jesus!
