

Where The Thirsty Find Life

"Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble, or be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

Joshua 1:9

It's been a little while, hasn't it? I hope that you have been blessed the last few months hearing from our staff in newsletter articles about the many ministries that are going on here at PSDUMC. I've truly enjoyed reading these articles and seeing how God is working. We are witnessing the movement of God among us through so many and to meet so many needs.

The phrase "be strong and courageous" appears a number of times in the Old Testament-particularly in three specific moments in history: Moses' words to Joshua at the end of Deuteronomy as the Israelites are across the Jordan River from the Promised Land; here at the beginning of Joshua as the angel of the Lord encourages Joshua as he takes charge; in both 1 Kings & 1 Chronicles as David charges his son Solomon to follow Yahweh as he had done. In each instance, words of encouragement are given to the one following in his footsteps.

But notice the words themselves; there is no specific action verb in these verses. If we look at the broader passage, the action verbs come when the angel tells Joshua to keep the laws of the covenant made at Mt. Sinai. When you look at the accounts of the battle narratives in Joshua, you find out very quickly that the battle is not won by the Israelites but by God himself. The Israelites simply find themselves as the beneficiary of God fighting on their side. They simply had to "be."

What if we lived that out today? So much of our lives are filled with the hustle and bustle, and I'm afraid that it leaks into our faith at times. "Just tell me what to do God, and I'll do it!" Do you ever say that? We don't like to be patient; we don't like to stand still. We don't like to just "be." But sometimes, that is exactly what God is calling us to do. Wait for a word from the Holy Spirit. Wait for the movement of God. Wait upon the Lord. Realize that it is not by our strength that we can accomplish anything, but when we wait on the Lord and see what he is doing in, around, and through us.


Wesley House - Care Lodge - Loves Kitchen
