1. A world view which is God-centered rather than man-centered.

3. The centrality of the Gospel of the forgiveness of sins for Christ's sake in the life of a Christian and the church.
4. Faithfully teaching the Word of God and passing on the language of our holy faith so that the baptized learn how to receive God's gifts in the Divine Service, how to pray, how to confess, and how to live where God has called them to live with faith in Christ and love to the neighbor.
5. The centrality of the Divine Service and daily prayer according to the church's historic and confessional liturgy of Word and sacrament.
6. A partnership and involvement with parents in every area of their child's education and spiritual growth.
7. An education based in the core disciplines and humanities: language arts, mathematics, science, social studies, religion, music, art, and the use of technology.
8. Academic standards which demand excellence and achievement.
9. The teaching of singing and music in service to the church and for the prayer life of God's people.
10. The teaching of language and foreign language for learning the art of communication and rhetoric.
