

Dorsey Holtkamp Christian Education Scholarship Criteria

GUIDELINES

1. The Scholarship shall be awarded to a college student who is a member, or active participant, of Lebanon Presbyterian Church, who has a financial need and has expressed his/her intent to obtain a degree in Christian Ministry.
2. The recipient may apply for funds semiannually until he/she receives a bachelor's degree in Christian Education. The amount may be up to \$1,000 annually.
3. Recipients must attend a fully accredited college or university.
4. Funding will be available to those who plan to be full-time students.
5. The Scholarship Committee of five (5) individuals will interview the applicants and decide on the scholarship recipient and one alternate. These five individuals will represent Session, Deacons, Youth Ministry Group, Church Staff, and a church member at large.
6. The recipient will receive the funding when he/she presents a receipt from the college for tuition or other expenses as defined in the criteria below.

CRITERIA

1. Applicants must be active members, or an active participants, of Lebanon Presbyterian Church.
2. Funds will be awarded to a student who has been involved in ministry and service at LPC and in his/her community.
3. Consideration will be given to the applicant's academic achievements and long range goals. Student's total GPA must not fall below a 2.5, verifiable by the student's college.
4. If the person selected happens to receive full scholarship from another source, the recipient will then be expected to return the LPC scholarship money. Available money will be divided among eligible applicants (up to \$1,000.00).
5. Christian Ministry is defined as a vocation of Christian service, including but not limited to Pastorship of a church, Minister of Youth & Education, Minister of Pastoral Care, Minister of Student Ministries, Director of Small Group Ministries, missionary or missionary teacher, counselor, and Minister of Worship & Music. Course work is subject to approval.

SELECTION PROCESS

1. Funding applications are available in the Lebanon Presbyterian Church Office.
2. Applications must be submitted by April 15th of the year funds are to be awarded.
3. Funding will be announced on Graduation Sunday each spring.
4. An initial personal interview will be held with each applicant after the applications are reviewed. Students in good standing will just have to renew their application of intent each year. Committee has authority to request additional interviews as necessary.
5. Members of the Scholarship Committee should resign if their child is applying.
