

# **The Vera S. Everitt Memorial Scholarship**

**This scholarship is to be known as the Vera S. Everitt Memorial Scholarship and will be used for the benefit of those pursuing a degree in the field of education. Vera S. Everitt taught elementary education in the Springboro school system for 28 years and was an active member of the Lebanon Presbyterian Church for over 50 years.**

## **Guidelines**

1. The Scholarship shall be awarded to a graduating high school senior or college student who is a member of Lebanon Presbyterian Church.
2. Up to \$1,000 will be awarded to the selected recipient.
3. Recipient must attend a fully accredited four-year college.
4. The Scholarship is available to those who plan to be full-time students in the field of education.
5. The LPC Scholarship Committee will consist of at least 5, but no more than 7 individuals. At least 3 of the individuals will be serving on (or have served on) Session, Deacons, Youth Ministry, and/or Church Staff.
6. If there is a conflict of interest between a committee member(s) and an applicant(s), the affected committee member(s) will excuse themselves from the process for that particular year.
7. Applicants will be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee and based on the below criteria a recipient(s) will be selected.

## **Criteria (in order of emphasis)**

1. Applicant must be a member of Lebanon Presbyterian Church.
2. Consideration will be given to the responses of the questions asked on the Application and based on their passion and desire to become an educator.
3. Consideration will be given to the applicant's involvement in community, school, and extra-curricular activities.
4. Consideration will be given to the applicant's academic achievements and long range goals. Student's total GPA must not fall below a 2.5, verifiable by the student's college.
5. Consideration will be given to the applicant's financial need.
6. If the recipient happens to receive full scholarship from another source, the recipient will then be expected to return the LPC scholarship money. The alternate candidate will then receive the money.
