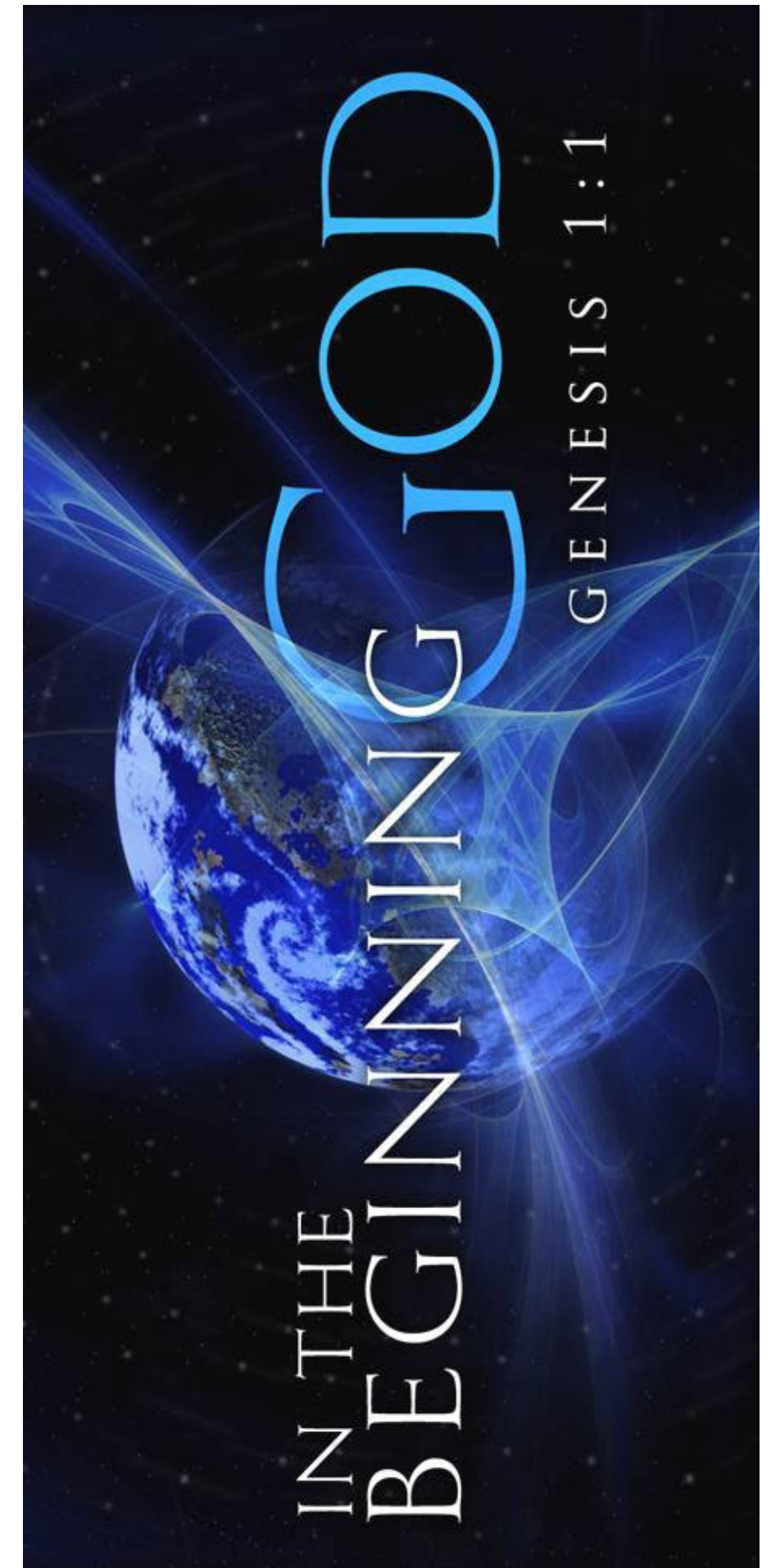

Faith and Science

The God who made the world and everything in it is the Lord of heaven and earth and does not live in temples made by human hands....
- Acts 17:24

William Bragg, a pioneer in the field of X-ray crystallography, was once asked if faith and science were opposed to each other.

“Yes, they are,” said Bragg, “in the way that the thumb and fingers of my hand are opposed to one another. It is an opposition by means of which anything can be grasped.”

Bragg was right. When we study the laws of science and nature, it should draw us closer to God. In the DNA double helix or the intricate design of the human eye, we behold an intelligence far beyond our own.

Many great scientists believed in God, including Copernicus, Kepler, Galileo, Newton, Leibniz, Descartes, Pascal, Boyle, Faraday, Mendel, Kelvin, Planck and Einstein. Dr. Francis Collins, who headed the Human Genome project and the National Institutes of Health, is a man of deep faith and a committed Christian. Science is a wonderful tool that can point us toward our Creator. But science cannot answer the ultimate questions of life. For that, we need the truth of God revealed to us in the Bible.

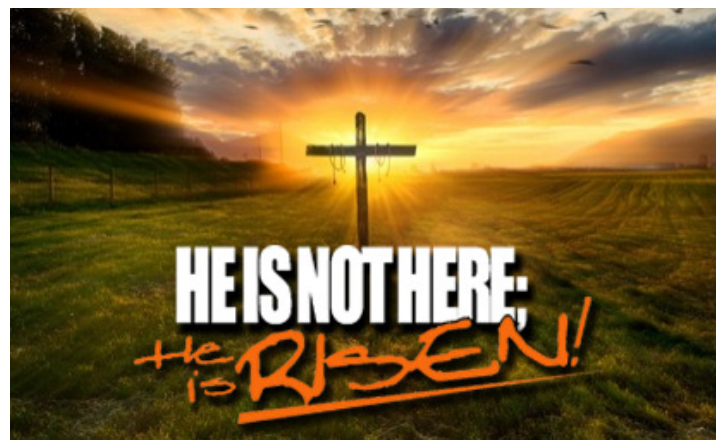

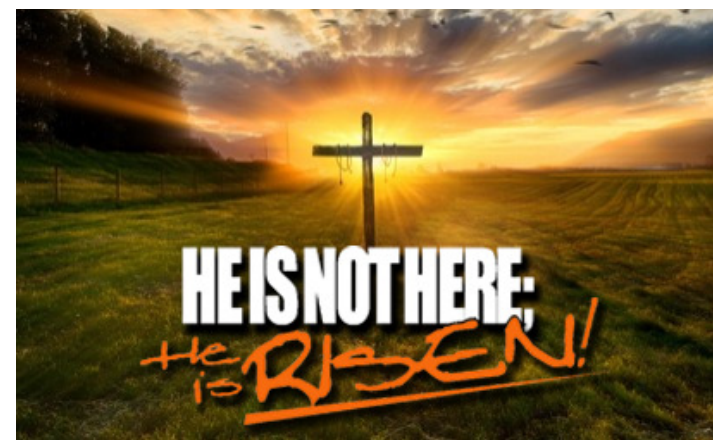

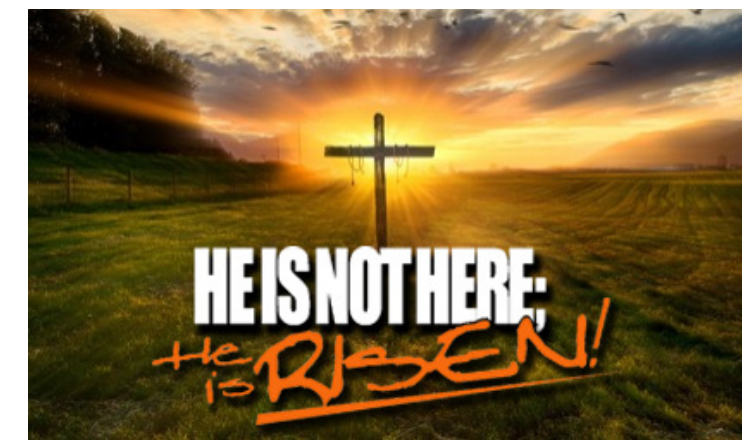
