Where Did I Come From?



For you created me in my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made...

Fearfully and Wonderfully Made

For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb.
- Psalm 139:13

Alexander Tsiaras is a professor at the Yale Department of Medicine. At a recent TED conference, he awed the crowd with a speeded-up video showing the fetal stages of development from conception to birth.

Using an MRI technique, the video shows how the hair, skin, nail, bones, tendon, gut, cartilage, and blood vessels are formed out of a rope-like protein called collagen. The collagen changes its structure only once – to form the cornea of the eye - where it spontaneously forms a transparent grid pattern.

Dropping his scientific objectivity, Tsiaras explained: “The complexity of the mathematical model of how these things are done is beyond human comprehension. Even though I am a mathematician, I look at this with marvel: How do these instruction sets not make mistakes as they build what is in us? It’s a mystery, it’s magic, it’s divinity.”

Nearly 3,000 years ago, King David wrote these words: “I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.” (Psalm 139:14). With the help of modern science, we can now see the incredible truth of those words.

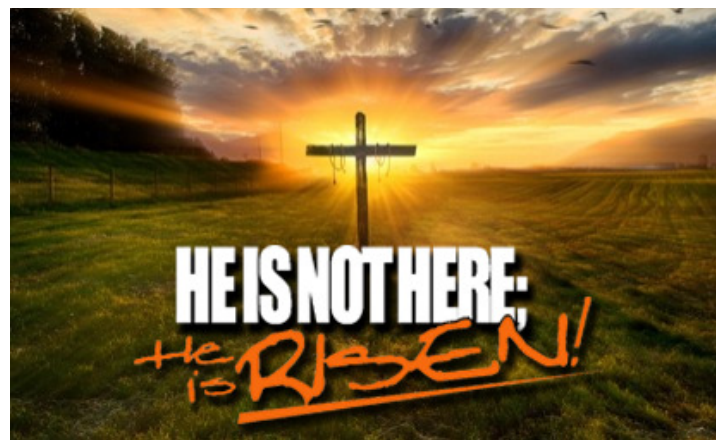

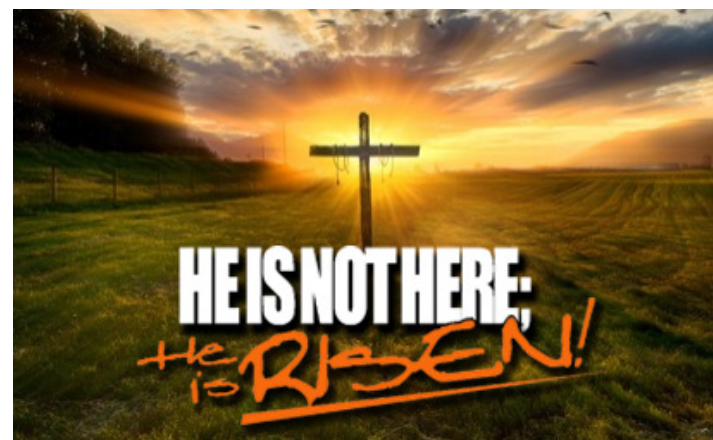
