Communion

I grew up in a church where all the kids spent two years learning about the Christian faith in a confirmation class. A big part of that class was learning about Holy Communion – something we also do here at LPC.

One of the things that has stayed with me about that class is the meaning of communion. My pastor wanted us to understand that communion is not a snack in the middle of worship or something we should do without thinking. It is a time to confess your sins and remember how Jesus died to save you from them. He used the same passage from 1 Corinthians we are hearing today to help us understand this. I hope hearing it today will have the same effect on you that it had on me when I was your age. I hope it will help you understand just how special Holy Communion is.

Soul Food: A Word from Peter

Home Alone

For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them.
- Matthew 18:20

Recently, I was speaking with a woman who is unable to come to worship because of some health issues. I offered to bring her communion. “No thanks,” she said. “I don’t need it. I serve communion to myself every day.”

Her words surprised me. You see, communion is not something we can do alone. By definition, communion takes place in community. It represents our oneness with Jesus Christ, but also our oneness with each other as the Body of Christ.

To think that we can take communion all by ourselves – privately – is a contradiction. It might sound very spiritual but in reality, it is self-centered. It ignores our connection with each other as members of His body.

Jesus said, “Where two or three are gathered in my name, I am with them.” Those words express a deep truth. We cannot follow Jesus all alone, privately. We need the physical presence of other Christians to experience the presence and power of our LORD Jesus.
