Worshipping as the Children of God

We are here this morning to worship and praise God through music, listen to God's Word, pray, and give our offerings. But we are also here to be together. And we need to do these things together.

In today's scripture, Paul describes how people at the church in Corinth were not really worshipping together. One person would stand up and start singing while another person was reading scripture. Then, another person would start a prayer. No one was paying attention to anyone else.

Throughout the Bible, God makes it clear that he wants us to worship together – to pay attention to each other and to experience what it means to be a community of faith. When we do this, we can learn to love like He does, putting others before ourselves.


