Sunday, March 3 OR Wednesday, March 6

Or, simply follow the activity outline below!

1. Remember the start of Lent by wearing purple
2. Do something kind (but don't get seen!)
3. Read John 3:16
4. Pray for your Pastor

Sunday—Thank Jesus that you got to hear his Word today

5. Ask Jesus to help you in school
6. Help a friend, brother or sister
7. Read Hebrews 12:2
8. Thank Jesus that he died for you.
9. Pray for your family.
10. Say "Thank You" to five different people

Sunday—Thank your Pastor for sharing God's Word

11. Pick up trash, feed a pet, or recycle
12. Pray for someone who is sick or sad
13. Thank your parents for taking care of you
14. Ask Jesus to forgive you
15. Think about how much God loves you
16. Read 2 Corinthians 13:14

Sunday—Listen in church to hear what God is telling you

17. Thank your teacher for helping you in school
18. Pray about something you sometimes worry about
19. Thank Jesus for being your friend no matter what
20. Look for a way to be kind to someone

21. Thank Jesus for your family
22. Pray for everyone who teaches God's Word

Sunday—Think about what you hear in church this weekend

23. Pray for your family when you wake up
24. Read 1 John 3:1
25. Tell someone, "Jesus loves you!"
26. Finish this prayer: "Dear Jesus, I'm sorry..."
27. Share something you like a lot with a friend
28. Pray for your grandmas and grandpas

Sunday—Read Mark 10:13-16

29. Finish this prayer: "Dear Jesus, I'm so glad you love me..."
30. Do something kind for your teacher at school
31. Clean your room without being asked
32. Talk to Jesus before you go to sleep tonight
33. Read Romans 6:23
34. Ask Jesus to help you listen in church this weekend

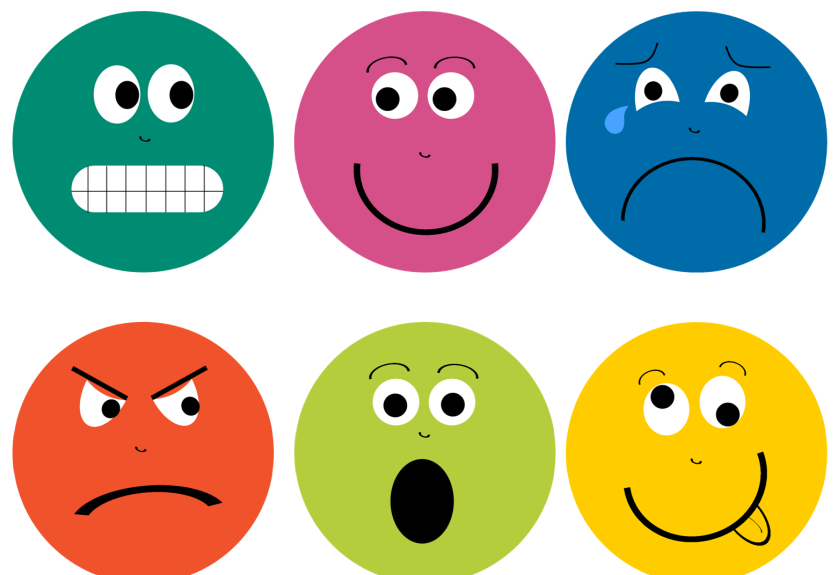

The LPC Sanctuary Choir will share piece called *Lenten Sketches* beginning at 7:00 p.m.

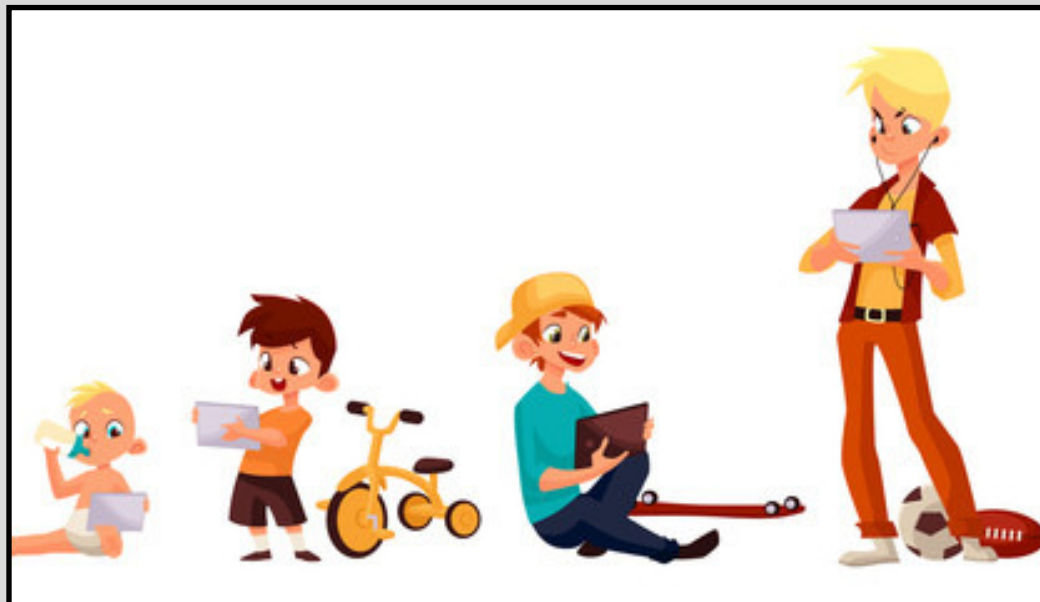
4/21—Easter Sunday
