I pray and hope you are doing fine. I have a couple of nice updates to share with you:

SAVED!

If you remember the testimony I shared while I was on furlough about the little orphan boy at our orphanage named Sam. You may recall how he said to me one day that when he grows up he wants to be a pastor. I am excited to let you know today that Sam has now accepted Christ as his Savior. Sam is saved! Dr. Mark Renner, a long-time ministry partner, led little Sam to the Lord while on a mission trip here with a mission team from his home church.

A FRUITFUL MISSION TRIP

The mission team from South Dakota under the leadership of pastor Rick had a blessed missionary journey in Haiti. During their 7-day stay on the ground here, they bonded with our orphanage children; held VBS and served lunch at our Delmas Children School and Feeding Center; had 2 mornings of arts and crafts with our Duguay Baptist church ladies; shared testimonies and worshipped with the church; preached and taught seminars at our theological Bible Institute; did soul-winning efforts in the Duguay community; built along with the Haitian brethren a 495 square foot room for Duguay's children church; and yet had time to go up in the hills of Fermathe to sightsee the beauty of Haiti's hills. We will give you free transportation via our orphanage bus from the hotel to the church auditorium. The Palm Inn has an onsite restaurant with very affordable food prices menu. The activities will start on July 30 and go through August 4. If you do not want to stay the entire time, then we encourage you to come for the weekend of August 2-4.
