
## UPDATE FROM THE ORPHANAGE

You might remember Chichi. Her mother had relinquished guardian rights for her to our orphanage, then went to Santo Domingo. She has never returned, and we don't know if she is even still alive. Chichi was only 3 months old and HIV positive when she came to us. We arranged for Chichi to stay with a foster family for a time, and had her taken to the center for disease in Port-au-Prince for treatment. In about 2 years she became HIV-free and a healthy little girl. I glorify God for the advances of medical science. Chichi has now returned to the orphanage. She is super smart kiddo who is going to be 3 years old.

Also, I am happy to report that Obed, who is now 3 years old, got his third and final eye surgery done in Fort Worth, Texas. The surgeries appear to have been a success in correcting the strabismus (cross-eye), and he is now scheduled for post-surgery check-ups. Please continue to pray for this little guy – God has big plans for Obed!

## UPDATE FROM THE CHILDREN FEEDING AND LEARNING CENTER

Our Feeding Center in Hatt has been very effective, with 152 children in attendance. The caretaker of the Hatt center will soon be leaving Haiti to join her husband who is living in the country of Chile. She is a very reliable person and it will be difficult to replace her.
