Also, our two guest speakers from stateside will come for the weekend of August 4-6 with seminars, sweet fellowship, workshops, praise and worship and vibrant preaching on the theme of the Fellowship which is "Our main mission is the great commission." We very much appreciate the partners who could accept our invitation, among whom is our keynote speaker, Pastor Rick Henry of First Baptist Church in Canton, Michigan. Please pray for a harvest of souls, reinforcement of our fellowship churches, and many blessings.

## IN JESUS NAME WE WILL BUILD THE BIBLE SEMINARY CAMPUS.....YES WE WILL!

Dear partnering prayer warriors, we badly need your help in asking our God for his intervention to help us acquire this property in Haiti less than a mile from the orphanage for our Bible seminary.

West Orlando Baptist church donated \$14,500 and Basehor Baptist Church donated \$2,500 towards the purchase of a \$20,000 piece of land for the seminary. We were not able to find a piece of land for \$20,000 or \$17,000; however, there is an open door to buy a slightly damaged two story property sitting on a nice piece of land twice the size of the land we hoped for and located less than a mile from my house near a main road.



The inconvenience is the tag price of \$115,000. We have \$17,000 and would need \$98,000. This is a very large amount of money; however, our God owns the world in his hands and I know it will take a miracle for this to come true. The good news is God still does miracles. Please pray for God's perfect will to be done for the seminary.

## KHAN ACADEMY IN THE ORPHANAGE SCHOOL

With the help of an anonymous precious partner who made the trip to Haiti this July we were able to start the Khan Academy free school in the orphanage starting with our older kids such as Wislin, Kandy and Nana. Kahn Academy is a truly a world-class education. This ministry partner was able to set up the server and quickly trained two young men - Jocelyn and Reggy - to help assist the students. Reggy is our Duguay pastor. Jocelyn is a young Haitian who recently graduated from a Christian college in Texas, and has returned to serve in his homeland of Haiti. The wifi server does not require internet access and can support 10-20 tablets. We have 4 tablets for the time being. The server is loaded with Khan Academy, the Bible and more in the French language. On school days each student under supervision walks inside our small school room, gets his tablet, logs on, and accesses the network server. They study at their own pace with practice exercises and instructional videos. The curriculum covers math, science, computer programming, history, economics, and more. We are testing it right now and hope to extend it to other Christian schools once it proves to be successful.
