Folks, God did it!! He heard our prayers. Our first Haiti Independent Baptist Fellowship reached its goal and more. Each day from 5:00 in the morning to 8:15 in the evening the Holy Spirit truly led our workshops, discussion panels, awesome praise and worship, youth rally, prayer services and biblical sermons on the great commission by several Haitian pastors and two American pastors. Although it was very hot and humid, it was powerful and renewing for the soul! Our keynote speaker was Pastor Rick Henry of First Baptist Church in Canton, Michigan, and our guest Missions Pastor was Josiah Boyd of Beltway Park Church in Abilene, Texas.

It was a real blessing to have *Eglise Baptiste de l'Habitation Hatt* hosting the Fellowship. This is the church whose building collapsed during the 2010 earthquake and was rebuilt last year. The new sanctuary has a seating capacity of 1,200 people and has the media equipment to support our major annual events for Jesus.

There was a total of 340 folks who made up 10 out-of-town church delegations that came from the south, west and east of the island to join our large hosting church for the fellowship.

During the evening of August 6 - which was the last day of the Fellowship - God sent a very powerful sermon through our keynote speaker Rick Henry. This resulted in more than 50 church workers, including our 11 church pastors to come forward and pray for new boldness regarding the great commission. Praise God and thank you pastor Henry for preaching the living words.

We all know about the trials our southern churches have gone through as a result of the 2016 hurricane. Yet they had the heart to give 1 young cow, 4 adult goats and 2 turkeys to help feed the church delegations. This touched me so much and reminded me of the Macedonian churches in 2 Corinthians 8. On their way back home, one of the buses carrying a group from the Southern delegations turned over, but miraculously everyone came out alive.
