Hello ministry partners,

By God's grace life has returned to normal just in time for us to attend our 8-day 2018 Fellowship along with our full evangelistic efforts, July 29 through August 5. This year's meeting was hosted by one of our churches in the Southern rural mountains of Haiti, First Baptist Church of Vilpy. For this, our 10 church delegations travelled 3 hours by buses, then a half hour by foot to get there. The only public-school compound near the church was turned into a camp to lodge our 500 attendees.



We climbed mountains to herald the gospel door-to-door.

Every morning we woke up early at 5am to pray and praise. Then we left the Vilpy camp to climb the mountains like an army from 9am to 2:30pm going house-to-house proclaiming the gospel of Christ to all including more than 6 voodoo priests in a nearby voodoo stronghold village called Verdin. Then we returned to the Vilpy Camp to eat together, hold Spirit-filled worship services, and listen to a Bible sermon every evening until 9pm at the First Baptist Church. This continued for 8 days.



The folks we evangelized live in hilly areas only reachable by donkey. What brought us joy is that 46 folks gave their lives to Jesus - to God only be the glory! At the end of the 8 days we left First Baptist Church of Vilpi with tears of joy on both sides knowing that their leaders are committed to supporting the newly-planted church



As a nurse Marie provided medical help to those in need.

There were hundreds of us, including entire families, like an army spreading boldly the good news that only Jesus saves!
