Dear ministry partners and friends,

As I write this mission update to you, the country of Haiti is being torn with political unrest as it has happened several times before; however, the difference is it is very violent this time. Most peaceful people stay indoors, all businesses, grocery stores and schools are closed. Food prices have been jacked up terribly. The streets are filled with smoke from burning tires. The police are using tear gas and gunshots to counter the crowds. Now enough of the bad news - let us now focus on two special things God has done in our ministries.



### SOUL-WINNING MISSION AND CHURCH CONVENTION IN JULY AND AUGUST

These pictures will give you an idea of our annual soul-winning mission and convention in a southern city of the island called Cavaillon. It was an 8-day event from July 28 to August 4. Ten of our eleven churches sent delegations of leaders and missionaries. We had an attendance of 410 souls. Here is what the Mission and Church Convention consisted of:



- Gospel Parade and March in the city proclaiming the gospel.
- Bible study, seminar on the great doctrines of Christianity, and communion.
- Good preaching by our keynote speaker and friend, pastor Rick Henry of First Baptist Church, Canton, Michigan.
- Door to door, roadside, and public market evangelism.

We witnessed to 1,025 souls and as a result **148 people got saved** including 2 voodoo priests! 17 backslidden Christians were restored, 14 were baptized in the city's river, and one couple who were living in fornication got married. This is all to the glory of God through Christ our Lord.
