I trust this finds you doing just fine by God's grace. Pretty soon it is going to be Christmas, a time to remember the story of this little baby, born in a stable, who was not only God in the flesh, but the gift of a loving God to humanity. God identified with us by being born into our midst and dying on a rugged cross for our salvation. He was and is the promised Redeemer of the world, God Incarnate who died for sinners that we might be saved. This is the message of God's love for humanity.

## CHRISTMAS DONATION FOR THE CHILDREN

As the Christmas season comes and this year is coming to an end, we are asking for your Christmas donation, God willing, on behalf of our Haitian children in Haiti, in the Dominican and in Tampa, Florida. We will donate toys for those in the Dominican and Tampa, but to the ones in Haiti we plan to give away toiletry kits and a hot meal instead because the toy stores in Haiti are closed and unable to import toys this year. This is due to the current insecurity and gang activities that have overpowered Haiti, and a border conflict between Haiti and the Dominican. However, if we receive enough donations to cover the cost of purchasing toys in the U.S., air shipping them to Haiti, and clearing Haiti customs, we would be able to bless the children in Haiti with toys this Christmas. This is an expensive option, so please prayerfully consider what you can give.

## SPECIAL CHRISTMAS DONATION FOR PASTOR FAMILIES

We would also like to give a special love donation for Christmas to those pastors in Haiti who have been through recent trials:

1. **Pastor Chrisnel** is pastor of the Dugue church in Croix des Bouquets, which is one of the disbanded churches. His wife and children who have been very traumatized were granted permission to leave Haiti to go live in Canada. Please pray for Pastor Chrisnel. He is expected to join his family soon, God willing.
2. **Pastor Judnès** was the pastor of the Santo church which was disbanded the same way. He and his family's lives were spared and he is now living with his family of 8 at his in-laws in a southeast part of Haiti called Thiotte.
3. **Pastor Isaac** who had pastored the Onaville church has now moved to Northern Haiti. He and his family of 4 are living with his in-laws. As you know, several of his church leaders were gunned down and burned.

## REGARDING FURLOUGH

We started furlough and are now traveling to churches in Florida, reporting until February. In the meantime, I am currently scheduling plans to travel to Texas starting March 2024. As I report to my supporting churches, I also need to add more supporting churches to help financially support our three front ministries among the Haitians. Thus far we have not picked up any new church. Please pray for us, for our God is more than able.
