more security for the property, it's caretakers, the girls that reside in the LifeHouse and Paloma, a security guard house is being built and the wall is being raised.

Visionland is 46 acres of land that is located outside of the city of San Pedro on the road that leads to Ramon Santana. Currently, there is a soccer field that is used in the sports ministry in association with Las Palmas Christian School, and a baseball field that is used for practices and games among teams in the city and by coaches using baseball as a tool for ministry.



In the process of being built, is the Hodges Hosting
Villa (named after Doug and Paula Hodges – the first DR Vision missionaries in the area). It will
provide a quiet place for retreats for other missionary families, youth groups, and future mission
trip teams.

Berto and Yolisa Mota are the caretakers that live on the property with their children Brian, Joel, Yulasi, and Sarah. Berto is Felix Mota's (Pastor of IBERS) brother. He is my (John's) right hand on the property and you can find us working together making sure tractors, pumps, and electrical things are in working order as well as cutting grass, trimming trees, building the wall, or planting new flowers, shrubbery, and fruit or palm trees.

Visionland is just that – land with so much vision for ways to minister – not only to the people of the Dominican Republic – but, to families that serve here and mission teams that are willing to come and serve alongside us.
