



POLICIES

All the policies of this ministry come under the direction of the Mother’s Day Out staff and First Baptist Church, Spearman, Texas.

Day: Thursday

<u>Time:</u> Children:	9:00am – 3:00pm
Afternoon:	12:00pm – 3:00pm
Teachers:	8:30am – 3:30pm

Fees: The **non-refundable** \$50.00 registration fee is due during registration to secure your child’s spot. Checks should be made payable to FBC Mother’s Day Out. Tuition needs to be paid no later than the first Thursday of each month to the director. If payment has not been made by the 10th of the month a late charge of \$10.00 will be added. Reminders will be sent if payment is late. We do not give credit or refund if we must cancel for a funeral or bad weather. If your child is absent, the complete month’s tuition is still due.

PURPOSES OF THE PROGRAM

To provide experiences that will enable a child to grow spiritually, physically, intellectually and socially.

To provide a program that will enable our church to reach into homes of church members and our community with the good news of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and that our church cares for them and their needs.

To provide a time to take care of family responsibilities and church activities for parents of our children in Mother's Day Out.

INFORMATION SHEETS

Child information sheets, which include a medical permission form, must be filled out when registering children.

SCHOOL HOLIDAYS OR CANCELLATIONS

Our schedule will follow the regular public school calendar, with the exception of when we begin in September and end in May. Holidays will normally be the same as school holidays. In the event that we have a funeral at FBC on Thursday, you will be notified of the cancellation of MDO for that day to show respect for the family.

If bad weather prevents public schools from meeting, we will do likewise and you will receive a call that morning.

FOOD

We will begin our fun filled day at 9:00, so please try to bring your child in a timely manner so they won't feel rushed, and can have a few minutes to settle into the day. Please be sure to feed your child breakfast before they come. They will receive a mid-morning snack, but not breakfast. Each student will have a day they are to bring snacks for their class and will be notified a week in advance.

A lunch must be provided by the parent. Heating will be available for those lunches that need to be.

SUPPLIES

Each parent is asked to provide 2 bottles of juice for the year, 1 at the beginning of the year and 1 after Christmas break, as well as a backpack (large enough to fit a folder), lunch box, nap mat, box of crayons, and a pack of water colors.

LABELING

Please label all of your child's items that you bring for them. This will help with keeping their items together.

2 YEAR OLDS

Please bring a labeled Sippy Cup each week. If your child has not completed the potty-training process, please bring diapers and wipes each week as well as a change of clothes in their backpack

3 YEAR OLDS

If your child is more comfortable drinking from a sippy cup, please bring a labeled cup each week.

PRE-K

If your child attends morning Pre-K, you are responsible to pick them up from school and bring to MDO. We will not be responsible for any sort of transport to MDO.

SICK CHILDREN

No child will be accepted if he or she has a fever or appears to be ill. In the event your child becomes ill at MDO, the parent will be called to pick the child up.
