

LIBERTY 2021 SCRIPTURE MEMORY CHALLENGE

January: All Things New

1/3 John 13:34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

1/10 Hebrews 9:15 And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

1/17 Colossians 3:9-10 Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds, and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him,

1/24 Isaiah 65:17 "For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; And the former shall not be remembered or come to mind.

1/31 Revelation 3:12 He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go out no more. I will write on him the name of My God and the name of the city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God. And I will write on him My new name.

February: Faith

2/7 Habakkuk 2:4 Behold the proud, His soul is not upright in him; But the just shall live by his faith.

2/14 Romans 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

2/21 Luke 17:6 So the Lord said, "If you have faith as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,' and it would obey you.

2/28 Colossians 2:6-7 As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving.

March: Hope

3/7 Psalms 147:11 The LORD takes pleasure in those who fear Him, In those who hope in His mercy.

3/14 Romans 8:24 For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees?

3/21 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17 Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved us and given us everlasting consolation and good hope by grace, comfort your hearts and establish you in every good word and work.

3/28 1 Peter 3:15-16 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear; having a good conscience, that when they defame you as evildoers, those who revile your good conduct in Christ may be ashamed.

April: Love

2/7 Amos 5:15 Hate evil, love good; Establish justice in the gate. It may be that the LORD God of hosts Will be gracious to the remnant of Joseph.

2/14 Deuteronomy 10:12-13 And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, and to keep the commandments of the LORD and His statutes which I command you today for your good?

2/21 Psalms 145:20 The LORD preserves all who love Him, But all the wicked He will destroy.

2/28 James 1:12 Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.

May: Mercy

2/2 1 Chronicles 16:34 Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever.

2/9 Hosea 6:6 For I desire mercy and not sacrifice, And the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings.

2/16 Psalms 25:10 All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth, To such as keep His covenant and His testimonies.

2/23 Proverbs 28:13 He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.

2/30 Micah 6:8 He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the LORD require of you But to do justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God?

June: Truth

6/6 Joshua 24:14 "Now therefore, fear the LORD, serve Him in sincerity and in truth, and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the River and in Egypt. Serve the LORD!

6/13 John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

6/20 John 4:23 But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

6/27 Ephesians 1:13-14 In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory.

July: Justice

7/4 Deuteronomy 16:19 You shall not pervert justice; you shall not show partiality, nor take a bribe, for a bribe blinds the eyes of the wise and twists the words of the righteous.

7/11 Psalms 37:28 For the LORD loves justice, And does not forsake His saints; They are preserved forever, But the descendants of the wicked shall be cut off.

7/18 Psalms 82:3 Defend the poor and fatherless; Do justice to the afflicted and needy.

7/25 Exodus 23:2 You shall not follow a crowd to do evil; nor shall you testify in a dispute so as to turn aside after many to pervert justice.

August: Works

8/1 Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

8/8 1 Chronicles 16:11-12 Seek the LORD and His strength; Seek His face evermore! Remember His marvelous works which He has done, His wonders, and the judgments of His mouth,

8/15 Psalms 145:3-4 Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; And His greatness is unsearchable. One generation shall praise Your works to another, And shall declare Your mighty acts.

8/22 James 2:26 For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Titus 1:15-16 To the pure all things are pure, but to those who are defiled and unbelieving nothing is pure; but even their mind and conscience are defiled. [16] They profess to know God, but in works they deny Him, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work.

September: Repentance

9/5 Mark 2:17 When Jesus heard it, He said to them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance."

9/12 Luke 15:7 I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance.

9/19 Acts 5:30-31 The God of our fathers raised up Jesus whom you murdered by hanging on a tree. Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins.

9/26 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

October: Righteousness

10/3 Matthew 5:6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, For they shall be filled.

10/10 Matthew 5:10 Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

10/17 Acts 10:35 But in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him.

10/24 1 John 3:10 In this the children of God and the children of the devil are manifest: Whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor is he who does not love his brother.

10/31 Matthew 6:31-33 "Therefore do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

November: The Tongue

11/7 Proverbs 15:4 A wholesome tongue is a tree of life, But perverseness in it breaks the spirit.

11/14 Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

11/21 James 1:26 If anyone among you thinks he is religious, and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this one's religion is useless.

11/28 James 3:6 And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. The tongue is so set among our members that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire by hell.

December: Christ is Born

12/5 Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

12/12 Luke 2:10-11 Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.

12/19 Galatians 4:4-5 But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, [5] to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

12/26 John 18:37 Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice."
