

## Followed by Hot Dog Lunch

Lent is here, which means Easter is coming soon. The stores are filled with Easter egg candy, and we invite you to bring in candy for our **Easter Egg Hunt, Saturday, April 13, at 10:30**. This is the day before Palm Sunday. Bins for candy will be outside the church office.

Before the Egg Hunt begins, we will offer an "Easter Walk" in the CEC. Each child will be given a booklet that will guide them through the seven stations in our Easter Walk. At each station children will receive a memento associated with that station's message about Easter. After visiting each station, children will get their booklet stamped and will then move on to the next station. After they have gone through the seven stations, our Egg Hunts will begin!

***We promise that this is an easy job and just requires 30-45 minutes of your time.***

<b>HOW TO HELP</b>	
<b>NOW</b>	<b>Bring in wrapped candy.</b> Bins for candy are outside the church office.
<b>Tuesday, April 9</b>	<b>9:30 – 12:00 → Stuff plastic eggs with candy.</b> Tables will be set up in the nursery with lots of eggs to stuff, and you can sit for this job. 😊
<b>Saturday, April 13</b>	<b>1) 9:30 → Hide eggs outside</b> <b>2) 10:15 → Hand out an Easter Walk item and stamp a child's booklet.</b> <b>3) 11:00 → Be a monitor during the hunt.</b>

As in the past, we will have three locations for our Egg Hunts:

2nd to 5th graders will hunt in the large playground by the side parking lot,  
Preschoolers through 1st grade will hunt in the back playground, and  
Toddlers will hunt between the buildings by the nursery.

To make this possible, we will need candy – as well as help in stuffing plastic eggs. We will stuff eggs on **Tuesday, April 9, from 9:30 to 12:00**. With enough help, we'll get it all done. Stuffing eggs has been so much fun in the past – it is a time when helpers visit and laugh with one another as they stuff lots of eggs. Please come help us stuff plastic eggs – and bring a friend!
