

# KZKZ QUARTERLY REPORT

(4th Quarter) 2013

During the 4th Quarter of 2013, (October - December) KZKZ aired programming that addressed issues of local concern. These issues included I-540 road construction updates, Chemical contamination cleanup at Whirlpool and surrounding properties, Health Insurance information sessions for the public, 4-Way Stop at Chaffee Crossing, AT&T and Verizon cell towers at Carol Ann Cross Park, and the proposed Greenwood sales tax vote for a new police station.

We also did a Holiday Food Drive with Community Services Clearinghouse during November at the Area CV Stores with afternoon broadcasts from the stores.

We also helped provide over 240 local foster children with Christmas toys working with DHS and local car dealers the first 3 weeks of December with afternoon broadcasts from the car dealers.

We did monthly interviews with the Community Services Clearinghouse, Sebastian County Solid Waste Management and Fort Smith , Greenwood, and Van Buren Police Departments.
