(3rd Quarter) 2013

During the 3rd Quarter of 2013, (July - September) KZKZ aired programming that addressed issues of local concern. These issues included I-540 road construction updates, Chemical contamination cleanup at Whirlpool and surrounding properties, Health Insurance information sessions for the public, No-Text it-Can-Wait Campaign, Thermold Magazines bringing new jobs to Ft. Smith, AT&T cell tower at Carol Ann Cross Park, Arming school staff, and the proposed Greenwood sales tax vote for a new police station.

We also conducted a blood drive in July on Rogers Avenue and got a very good response.

We did monthly interviews with the Community Services Clearinghouse, Sebastian County Solid Waste Management and Fort Smith and Van Buren Police Departments.

We also did 3 broadcasts for The United Way's "Stuff The Bus" Campaign, and had a great response in Booneville, Van Buren, and Greenwood.
