

KZKZ QUARTERLY REPORT

(2nd Quarter) 2013

During the 2nd Quarter of 2013, (April - June) KZKZ aired programming that addressed issues of local concern. These issues included tornado recovery efforts in LeFlore County and in Moore, OK, flood recovery efforts in Scott County, local neighborhood meetings in Ft. Smith, Contamination Studies near old Whirlpool property, the manufacture and sale of methamphetamine, legislative updates from 2013 Session, local economic conditions, and I-540 construction updates.

We also conducted a month-long Baby Shower in June to benefit local pregnancy centers: Hannah House, Heart to Heart Pregnancy Support Center, and Ft. Smith Pregnancy Help Center.

We did monthly interviews with the Community Services Clearinghouse, Sebastian County Solid Waste Management and the Greenwood and Ft. Smith Police Departments.
