

KZKZ QUARTERLY REPORT

(4th Quarter Oct-Dec) 2012

During the 4th Quarter of 2012, (Oct-Dec) KZKZ aired programming that addressed issues of local concern. These issues included post office closings,, local neighborhood meetings in Ft. Smith, terrorism, local crime prevention, local environmental concerns, the manufacture and sale of methamphetamine, driving under the influence, legislative updates, local economic conditions, the closing and loss of jobs at Whirlpool and Trane, local construction projects, road construction projects and detour information, child abuse, and educating the public on local scams, particularly with the elderly.

We also did monthly interviews with the Community Services Clearinghouse, the Sebastian County Solid Waste Management District, and the Ft. Smith Police Department.

We collected food for the Community Services Clearinghouse during November with remote broadcasts from local grocery stores. And we helped provide Christmas Gifts to 100 local foster children working with the Sebastian County Department of Human Services.
