

# KZKZ QUARTERLY REPORT

(1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Jan-Mar) 2012

During the 1st Quarter of 2012, (Jan-Mar) KZKZ aired programming that addressed issues of local concern. These issues included post office closings, government assistance for tornado victims, local neighborhood meetings in Ft. Smith, terrorism, local crime prevention, local environmental concerns, the manufacture and sale of methamphetamine, driving under the influence, legislative updates, local economic conditions, layoffs at Whirlpool and Trane, the proposed 1 percent restaurant tax in Ft. Smith, budget cuts within the City of Ft. Smith and City of Greenwood, local construction projects, road construction projects and detour information, and child abuse, pleas to the public for help in locating robbery suspects, credit card fraud, and local scams. We also aired interviews with Christian companion Senior Care concerning medical benefits and assistance for senior citizens. These interviews were approximately 3 minutes in length and took place between 6-9am and 3-6pm.

We also did monthly interviews with the Community Services Clearinghouse and the Sebastian County Solid Waste Management District.
