Debit and Credit Tithing:

You can conveniently tithe at the terminal in the Foyer.

The procedure is quite simple...1) choose "1 Sale Amount" 2) @ the prompt enter the amount you are offering without the decimal. 3) follow prompts 4) Insert, tap or swipe your card 5) Choose your account if appropriate. 6) Enter your personal identification number (PIN). 5) Please print both copies of the receipt. The merchant copy is to be put into an envelope that has your name on it and can be collected at offering time. The customer copy is your record of the transaction.
