

HELPS AND DEFINITIONS

<u>CIRCLE OF INFLUENCE (COI)</u> - The network of people I know and have a relationship (intimate, friendly, or not, neighborly, kin, rarely, seldom, occasionally, and future).

<u>FAMILY</u>-These people are the people who live in my home now.

RELATIVES- Family that does not live in my home.

NEIGHBORS- Someone who live near me.

<u>FRIENDS</u>- People I know well and see regularly and who are not my relatives.

AQUAINTENCES- People I know but not too well and may only see occasionally.

COWORKERS- People at my workplace.

<u>PERSON NEXT</u>- These are the people that I meet who become part of my circle of influence.

PRAYER- Intimate communication with God that results in action either by God, me, or both.

GOSPEL- The Good News that Jesus came to Earth as a baby born of a virgin. He lived a perfect, sinless life. He died on a cross to take my place as punishment for sin. His blood paid the price that God required for my sin. He was buried in a borrowed tomb to prove that He died. He rose for the dead after three days to prove that He had the power over sin, death, and hell. He promised if we believed with all our hearts and give our lives to Him, He will save us, and one day He will return to Earth, and we will live with Him forever.

MY TESTIMONY- Consists of three parts: 1. My live before I met Jesus. 2. How I met Jesus and gave my life to Him. 3. My life since following Jesus.

ROMAN'S ROAD- Romans 3:23; Romans 5:8; Romans 6:23; Romans 10:9-10; Romans 10:13.

The progression: Everyone has sinned and displeased God; God made a provision for our sin in Jesus coming to earth; Our sinful condition must be punished by God, but instead, Jesus took our punishment so we could be saved; We accept God's gift of salvation by faith, believing the facts about Jesus, asking God to forgive us, and to come into our lives.

ABC: We **ADMIT** that God is real and that we are sinners, **BELIEVE** that our sin will be punished and that Jesus can save us, and **COMMIT** our lives to God by: 1.) confessing our sin to Him and 2.) inviting Him into our lives to be our Lord and Savior. We express our desire to be forgiven and to make Jesus Lord by prayer.
