Davidson Apron Offering...

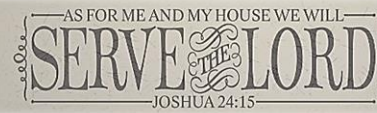
The apron offering received for Eli and Sheena Davidson totaled \$1,227.00. Thank you to each one who gave to encourage them and help them in their ministry.
