FREE FAMILY SWIM!!

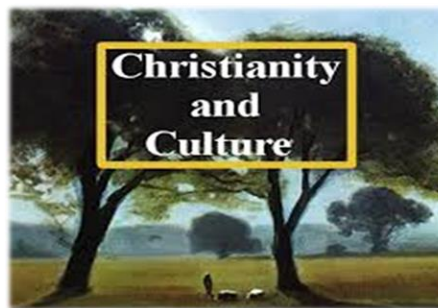
