We are now providing **limited nursery care** for children ages **1 year through 3 years** and Junior Worship for 3-year-olds through the 3rd grade during 10:45 worship.

COVID-19 Waivers and information sheets will need to be signed by all nursery and Junior Worship parents. Following are **some of the steps** we are taking for your child's safety in our nursery and during Junior Worship.

- ~"No-Touch" **temperature checks** will be taken on all children and staff each Sunday (99.5 max temp allowed)
- ~ **Hand Sanitizer** used when entering and leaving the Kid Zone
- ~ **NO** sippy cups, blankets, or snacks are to be brought into the Kid Zone
- ~ **NO** water fountain will be available

- ~ **Parents, please drop off and pick up your child(ren) promptly.**

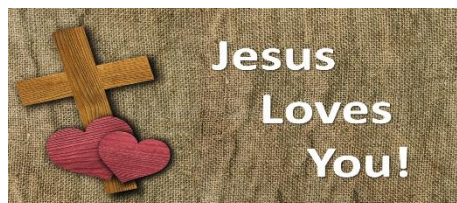
