Message from Pino

As I wrote at the end of June, Italy seemed to have emerged from the pandemic and the borders had reopened. People could move about freely between the states-regions that make up Italy. Unfortunately, when we became less cautious, the virus immediately began to surge. We are not at the levels of February-April (we have had about 35,600 deaths in Italy), but we have 4-5 deaths and about 1,000 new infections a day. The big driver is tourism. Normally, during the summer, some tens of millions of Europeans come to spend their holidays in Italy. This year there were far fewer, but still there were still several million. Our churches continue to observe all government mandates (masks, distances, sanitizing and no physical contact). Worship Have Resumed!

We are once again able to provide nursery care; however, it is **limited to 1-year-olds through 3-year-olds**. We also will have Junior Worship for 3-year-olds through 3rd grade during 10:45 worship. **COVID-19 Waivers and information sheets will need to be signed by all nursery and Junior Worship parents.** The following are some of the steps we are taking for your child's safety in the nursery and at Junior Worship. **(NOTE: If your child has a cough or runny nose they will NOT be admitted into the Kid Zone, even if their cough or runny nose is from allergies.)**

- ~ Please drop off and pick up your child(ren) promptly
- ~ **Temperature checks** taken (99.5 max temp allowed)
- ~ **Hand sanitizer** used when entering and leaving the Kid Zone
- ~ **NO sippy cups**, blankets, or snacks are to be brought into the Kid Zone
- ~ **NO water fountain** will be available
- ~ **NO older siblings** allowed in nursery
