


The Book of Revelation?

John, the writer of Revelation, wrote:

"Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear it and take to heart what is written in it, because the time is near." Revelation 1:3

What John is really saying here: You get a money-back guarantee if you read Revelation.

Revelation reveals Jesus Christ like no other book in the bible does. Truly, Jesus is at the center of this book.

And if Jesus is there, then we need to be there as well.

As Matt Proctor, president of Ozark Christian College, explains it: "Revelation tells how the story of God's people ends, and only when our people know the end of their story can they make sense of the story's middle where they live right now."
