
The new year offers an opportunity to not only reflect on [how God has worked through CCCC in 2016](#) but to look ahead on [where God is leading us in 2017](#)


The next [Ministry Team Leaders](#) Luncheon and Meeting is **Sunday, January 8**, following the Worship Service in the Fellowship Hall
