Welcome to all our guests today. Thank you for choosing to worship with us today. We pray you will receive a blessing and you will hear a Word from the Lord Jesus Christ. We serve an awesome Savior who loves us with an everlasting love. If you would, please fill out a visitor's card so we can be praying for you.

This Thursday we will be leaving to transport the mission barrels to Monrovia and Restoration Baptist Ministries. 15 barrels have been packed with care and love to disperse to the children and Pastor Joseph Johnson for Christmas. Thank you to all the 25+ folks who helped with the packing last Saturday. The barrels will be taken to Suku Express in Croydon, PA, to be shipped out on August 31st. If you would like to sponsor the shipment of a barrel or two the cost is \$125 per barrel. We estimate the value of each barrel at over a \$1,000. Thank you for your support and prayers.

Next Sunday, we will be starting three new Sunday School classes to continue to follow the Great Commission in Matthew 28:18-20 in making disciples.
