Please note the Finance Ministry Team will present the following change to our bylaws at the Wednesday, March 13th Business Meeting: (Article VII, Section 8: Finance Committee, §2, paragraph 5):

The Finance Committee shall be empowered to allow the Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, or Bookkeeper to make disbursements of up to ~~\$75.00~~ **\$125.00** without the approval of the Finance committee, if a ~~purchase order~~ **Request for Expenditure** has been filled out in advance. The Finance Committee shall in case of extreme emergency be allowed to approve an expenditure of up to but not more than \$100.00. All non-budgeted expenditures exceeding this amount must have the approval of the church. All designated monies must first be approved by the Finance Committee.
