Abby moves to approve Treasurer's Report, Jennifer seconds. Motion carries.

Learning Committee: No report

Worship & Music Committee

Choir will resume in February, Will sing February 19 in church, with practice before.

Robyn will have 2 pianos tuned – the one in the Sanctuary and one in the Small Fellowship Hall.

Will be using Setting 8 until Lent.

Will continue to use prepackaged Communion cups for Communion.

Wednesday evening services will be combined with Sunday Services during Lent.

Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, and Good Friday services will be held at 6:30 p.m.

Barb will organize Christmas decorations to be taken down on January 12.

Property Committee

Council discussed and John suggested not to pay for elevator maintenance this upcoming quarter. If they haven't come during the last quarter, then wait to pay. Council suggested to document to the times Curt/Connie have tried to call them, and to visit with other churches with elevators, like First Lutheran or Olivet, to see who services their elevators. Curt will talk to insurance about obligation to contract, or if we can just call as needed.

Electrical panel was updated and paid for from undesignated funds.

Holy Closure ballots: Pastor asked John Lindstrom if he would count the ballots, along with a Council member and a congregational member. Council agreed.

Abby moves to approve the Pastor's report. Jennifer seconds. Motion carries.

Prior Business

Pastor Caroline moves to continue to allow a port-a-potty on our parking lot property, unless issues arise, at which point we can call and cancel. Curt seconds, motion carries.

Pastor Caroline and Scott will pick up pizza for the annual meeting with a free-will offering to offset the costs.

Our last Open Forum will be held this coming Sunday, January 15. Council president asked Council members to be present for small group discussions.

New Business

Provisions to provide Holy Closure ballots to those unable to come to Worship (those in assisted living, nursing homes, or shut-ins). Elim has about 20 people in that situation. Pastor shared that definition from Elim's constitution, page 14, C10.4-C10.6, does not allow this.

Nominating Committee will turn in names for Council and Foundation by January 17.

Gasper's Dance Studio asked to borrow our old choir robes for an upcoming performance of Sister Act. Pastor moves to donate/allow use of old choir robes to/by Gaspers. Jennifer seconds, motion carries.

2023 Office Report: Jennifer moves to accept the office report, with the changes to confirmed membership. Curt seconds, motion carries.

2023 proposed budget was shared by John. After discussion and sharing how he tried to go from last year's with adjustments, he will turn into office for annual meeting.

Abby moves to adjourn, Curt seconds. Motion carries and meeting adjourns at 7:45 p.m. Pastor closed the meeting with prayer.

Balance Sheet

⇒ The checking acct balance is \$9,372.02. The balance at the beginning of the year was \$20,780.34. General Acct Fund balance at the end of December is -\$27,659.59.

Income and Expense (12/12 or 100% through the year)

- ⇒ Monthly pledge income was over budget (budget \$6,500.00 vs. \$7,737.00).
- ⇒ Monthly total income was over budget (budget \$8,733.00 vs. \$12,141.00).
- \Rightarrow YTD pledge income is 108.16% of the budget \$78,000 (actual \$84,361.00).
- ⇒ YTD total income is 112.67% of the budget \$104,800.00 (actual \$118,079.02).
- ⇒ Monthly expenses were under budget (budget \$12,513.00 vs. \$12,495.48).
- ⇒ YTD expenses are 97.08% of the budget \$150,153.00 (actual \$145,762.61)
- ⇒ The utility bill was \$1,996.06. Paid \$1,900 from Undesignated memorials to pay for a new electrical panel. Received \$5,500 in Prepaid pledges for 2023.






