**Balance Sheet**

- ◇ The checking acct balance is \$132.50. The balance at the beginning of the year was \$3,413.87. General Acct Fund balance after January is -\$2,950.75.

**Income and Expense (2/12 or 16.6% through the year)**

- ◇ Monthly pledge income was under budget (budget \$5,834.00 vs. \$4,390.00).
- ◇ Monthly total income was over budget (budget \$7,938.00 vs. \$10,243.24).
- ◇ YTD pledge income is 15.18% of the budget \$70,000 (actual \$10,625.00).
- ◇ YTD total income is 19.48% of the budget \$95,200.00 (actual \$18,549.24).
- ◇ Monthly expenses were over budget (budget \$9,659.00 vs. \$16,676.32). The higher expense was due to the annual insurance premium.
- ◇ YTD expenses are 23.09% of the budget \$115,724.00 (actual \$26,720.99)
- ◇ The utility bill was \$1,907.03. Paid the annual property insurance premium of \$8406.00. \$5,221 was taken from the Dishwasher designated fund. Sent \$1,000 to the Synod for Missionary Support that was given by the Foundation.

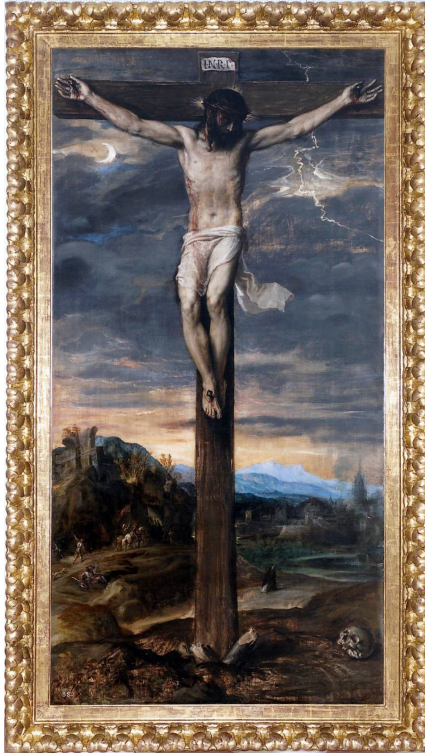

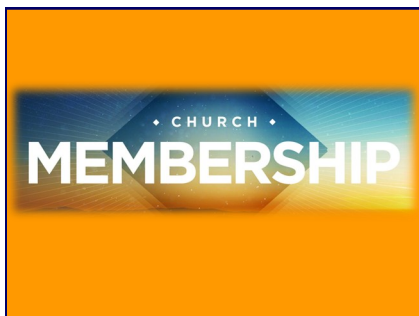
