 Drop off orders by 9:00 AM on the SCRIP Sundays, and they should be available for pickup on Thursday afternoon.

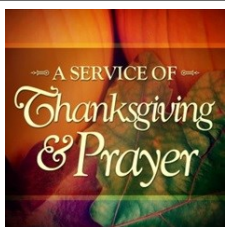
Note that with the holidays coming up we have added a few more dates/changed the schedule to our SCRIP calendar for the next two months.

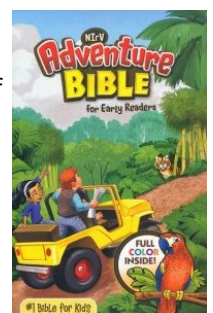


Thanksgiving Online Worship Service will be posted at Gloria Dei's Youtube link by noon on

Advent Season Series

Advent Theme this year: *Worship in the Waiting*. We will focus on this theme as we look forward to celebrating Jesus' arrival in our world.

We begin during worship on November 22nd (Christ the King Sunday).

It will involve worship, at home reflections and activities to ground ourselves in the waiting.

Each week we will focus on an element of this waiting: Waiting for a King, Holy Suspense, Active Patience, Hope-filled expectation, and Awe-Struck Anticipation.

To prepare: gather 5 candles (or battery operated) and place 4 in a circle and 1 in the center on your table or a common space in your home. We will light each candle during advent Sunday worship and you can participate during worship or during the week.

If you are in need of candles to use during advent, there are battery operated candles available for pick-up or delivery from Church. Contact the office if interested.
