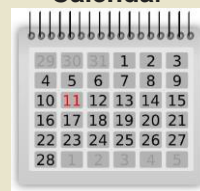


Landscape Workday **Saturday, February 20, at 1:00 p.m.**

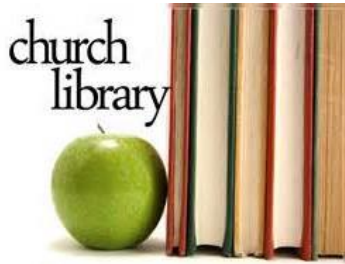

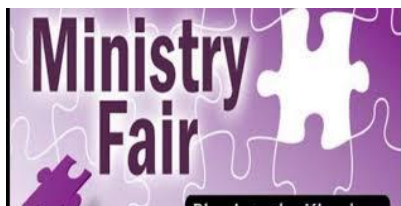
