1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

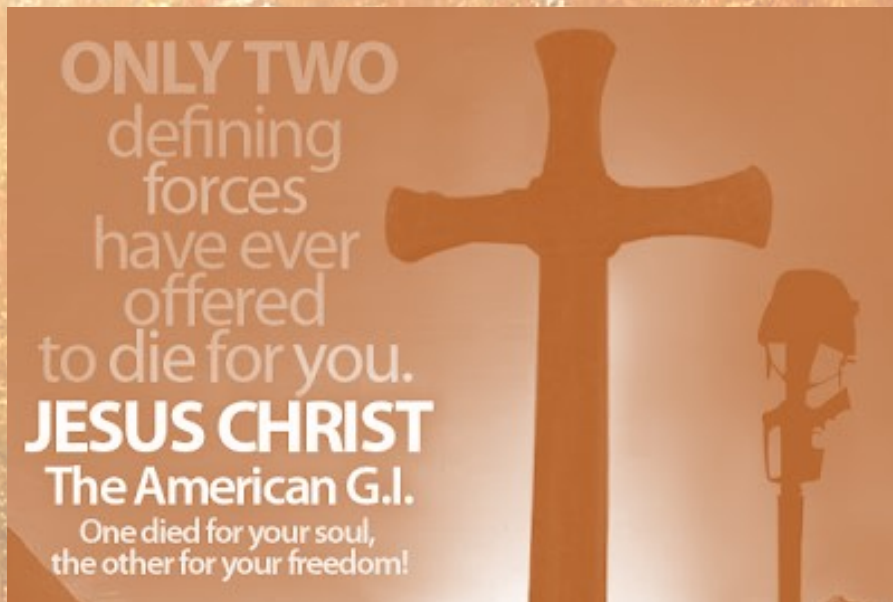
What do you do with this verse when you’re struggling to be thankful? Realize that God works in very mysterious ways, and even though we may not see it or understand it, God is working out His purpose.
