This Sunday, **May 20**, is Pentecost Sunday. Communion will be celebrated at both services. Please join us at the table of the Lord.

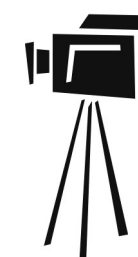
WEDNESDAY EVENING PRAYER MEETING

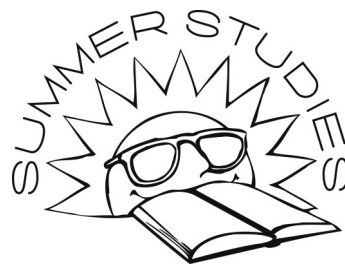
LOCAL DIRECTORY UPDATE
