

# Pennsylvania Would be Harmed by Withdrawing from NAFTA

By raising the costs of Pennsylvania exports and imports, a U.S. withdrawal from NAFTA would make Pennsylvania businesses and farmers less competitive, resulting in losses of jobs and production in the state and exports from the state to Canada and Mexico.

Estimated decline in Pennsylvania exports to Canada and Mexico if NAFTA is terminated

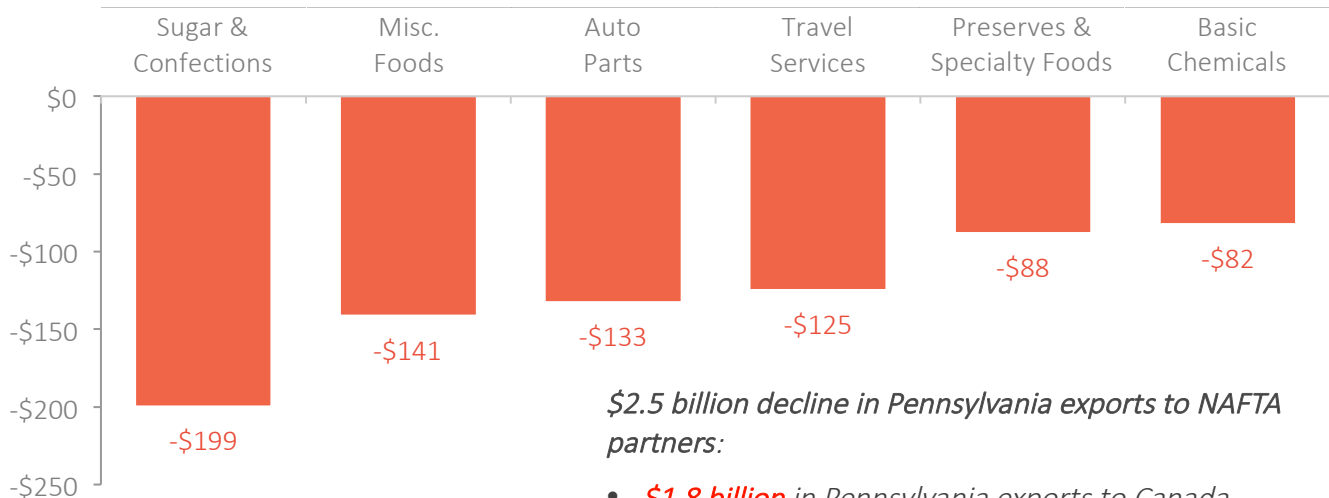
## Output Declines

## Vulnerable Pennsylvania Export Sectors

Estimated declines in select exports to Canada and Mexico if NAFTA is terminated (\$ Millions)



**\$2.5 billion decline in Pennsylvania exports to NAFTA partners:**

- **-\$1.8 billion** in Pennsylvania exports to Canada
- **-\$684 million** in Pennsylvania exports to Mexico

## Vulnerable Pennsylvania Export Products

Estimated declines in select exports to Canada and Mexico if NAFTA is terminated

# -\$75 million

**Ketchup and other condiments**

- Export Market: Canada
- Export Value: \$149 million
- Higher Tariff Rate: Up to 13%

# -\$35 million

**Chocolates and other cocoa products**

- Export Market: Mexico
- Export Value: \$55 million
- Higher Tariff Rate: 20%

# -\$27 million

**Brakes and brake parts**

- Export Market: Canada
- Export Value: \$103 million
- Higher Tariff Rate: Up to 6%
