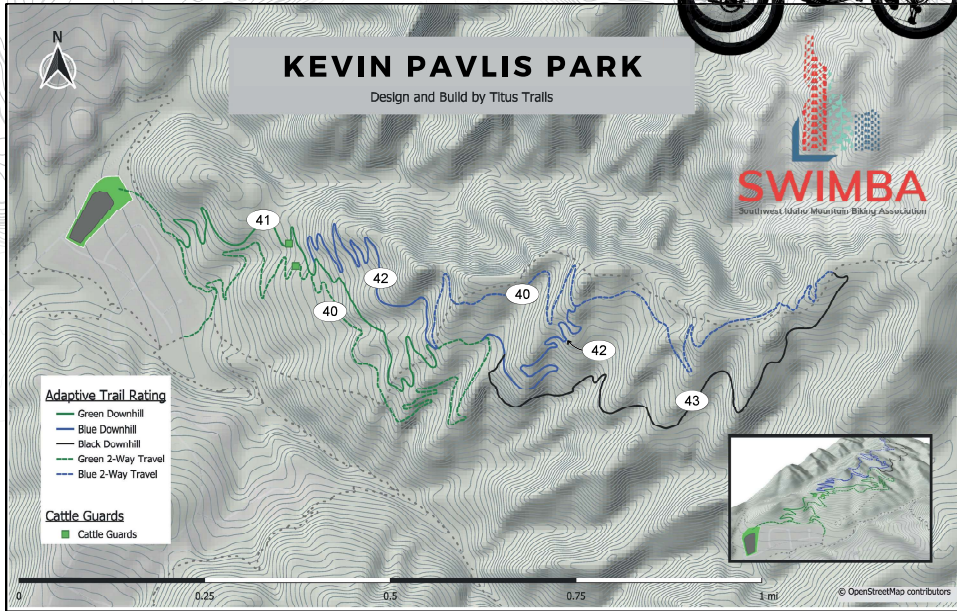

Nestled in the rolling sagebrush and grasslands of the Boise-Eagle foothills, the Avimor Trail System offers over 100 miles of unique pathways to explore. Here you'll find sweeping views, diverse wildlife, and endless opportunities for recreation and connection with nature. As you enjoy these special trails, please take a moment to review the Trail Rules & Etiquette below and do your part to be courteous to others and to help protect this remarkable landscape.

## TRAIL RULES & ETIQUETTE

- Only ride on **designated trails**.
- **Do not cut corners** or curves.
- Obey all temporary or permanent **trail closures**.
- Be mindful of **speed**. Do not slide or skid.
- Use **dog leashes on trails** as indicated on the map.
- **Pick-up** after your pets.
- **No motorized vehicles** without Avimor permission.
- Always **announce your presence** when passing.
- **Avoid muddy trails**. If you're making tracks - **turn back!**
- Motorized users **cut engines** when yielding to wildlife, livestock, or equestrian users.
- **Don't trespass** on private land. Remember: Avimor lands are still **private**.
