RX80's advanced formula allows it to be used with many different methods of carpet cleaning and on a multitude of different types of carpet fibers. When you add all of this to RX80's ability to kill odor causing bacteria, it may be the only carpet cleaner you'll ever need.



Description

RX80 is a unique carpet solution developed in our laboratories and as one can see by the EPA registration number, is exclusive to our company. RX80 contains a concentrated blend of powerful quaternary ammonium compounds and low foam surfactants that clean, sanitize and, with AIRICIDE®, deodorize the carpet and the whole area. RX80 can be used with all makes of extraction equipment, all techniques of bonnet cleaning, even rotary shampooing. And because it leaves no sticky residue, it can be used with the new low moisture method of carpet maintenance in which dilute cleaner is sprayed over the carpet and lightly buffed in. We have not seen that method on other companies' labels approved by the EPA.

Uses

For all washable, synthetic fiber carpeting, but particularly for cleaning and deodorizing carpets in hospitals, nursing homes, nurseries, locker rooms, restaurants, etc., where putrefactive bacteria and odors can be a problem. Like most sanitizing products RX80 is cationic and is not recommended for use on stain resistant nylon carpeting.

Benefits

- RX80 SPECIFICALLY FOR CARPET:** Competitive products are typically hard surface cleaners and can leave a sticky film on carpet fibers.
- EPA REGISTERED:** RX80 has been granted EPA Reg. No. 1459-74-44089 attesting to the Federal Government’s review and acceptance of label claims.
- PATENTED:** RX80 removes greasy, oily soil without need for added solvents. The detergent system is so unique in this regard that it has been granted patents in the U.S. and Canada.
- EASIER CLEAN-UP:** Has superior ability to suspend oily soil. Eliminates the redeposition of soil in vacuum wands and pick-up tanks, making them much easier to clean after use.
- CONTAINS AIRICIDE® ODOR COUNTERACTANT:** To remove foul odors already in the air and carpet, leaving the entire room smelling fresh and clean.
- ECONOMICAL:** Inexpensive to use. Each gallon of RX80 cleans approximately 2500 sq. ft. That’s well under 1¢ per square foot – but your biggest savings coming from the soil resistance of RX80 postponing or eliminating the need for the next cleaning.
- RESISTS RESOILING:** RX80 leaves no sticky residue allowing for its use by the new quick, easy LMC spray & buff method as described on the EPA approved label. Other manufacturers can not make this statement.

Directions

- Vacuum carpets before cleaning.
- TO CLEAN, SANITIZE, AND DEODORIZE CARPETS THROUGH EXTRACTION:** Mix two ounces of this sanitizing carpet cleaner per gallon of water. Inject and extract as you would with other “steam cleaning” shampoos.
- TO CLEAN, SANITIZE, AND DEODORIZE CARPETS THROUGH BONNET CLEANING:** Mix one part RX80 with eight parts (16 oz. per gallon) of warm water. Spray on carpet at the rate of 200-300 sq. ft. per gallon. Scrub with rotary floor machine equipped with spray-clean bonnet or pad.
- SPRAY & BRUSH CLEANING:** Mix one part cleaner with eight parts water (16 oz. per gal.). Spray evenly over carpet to remain wet 10 minutes. Then brush into carpet with a light machine or manually.
- SPOT CLEANING:** Mix one part cleaner with eight parts water and apply liberally with a sprayer or flip cap. With a soft cloth or brush, rub spot from edge towards its center to prevent spreading.
- NOTE:** Test for color fastness of carpet before use. Apply diluted cleaner to a small, out-of-the-way spot of carpet, then rub with a clean white cloth. If color transfers to cloth or changes, a water based product should not be used. After cleaning, place aluminum foil or wax paper under legs of furniture, while carpet is drying. Over-wetting can cause shrinking of the carpet. Manufacturer assumes no responsibility for over-wetting.
