“Let brotherly love continue”

Our first nursing home singing was a great success! Despite having a dozen folks sick who had planned to go, we had a dozen or so present for a good period of singing. The residents participated with us, making it just that much better! I visited the nursing home twice in the week following and the response from the residents and staff was very good!

I mentioned renewing the “Christmas tithe” to help the kids at North Alabama Christian Children’s Home. If you recall, two years ago this plan helped us to give \$4500 to widows and orphans in India. The plan works this way –

1. Figure 10% (a “tithe”) of what you spent on Christmas in 2017.
2. Divide that number by 10 again and save that amount each month.

So, if you spent \$500 at Christmas, \$50 is a tenth of that. Now, divide \$50 by 10 again and you get \$5. Thus, if you save \$5 a month between now and the first of November, you will have your “Christmas tithe” saved. As the time draws nearer, we will select a day to collect our savings. I will contact NAACH Director Don Williams to see how we can best use these funds to make for a special Christmas for the kids.

Many commented about the proposed changes to our meet-eat-meet Sundays and the results are in... ALL responses were in favor of doing an extended service before the fellowship meal rather than attempting to have a singing afterward. I don’t know when we will schedule a meet-eat-meet, but it will probably be in February or early March.

Also, as noted on the previous page, our Community Stew will be January 28. Our monthly singing will be moved to that night as Steve Gober will be here on Sunday evening, January 21, to report on the work at World Bible School. World Bible School is the publisher of the small brown ESV Bibles that we keep on hand to give away.
