# The Granby Education Foundation

The Granby Education Foundation (GEF) is an all-volunteer, nonprofit organization committed to lifelong learning and arts for all Granby citizens. For over 20 years, the GEF has been a vital funding partner for Granby's nonprofits and schools, ensuring quality education opportunities to pursue knowledge and expand horizons.

Most recently, the GEF gave over \$100,000 as a Special Project grant to build a TV studio and production center at GMHS. Previous Special Projects include the purchase of violins for the school district's Strings Program, building the Salmon Brook Ecology Center at GMMS, creating an Arts Endowment, and funding the Summer Drama Academy and Global Learning Academy.

During the 2022-23 school year, the GEF funded 14 grants totaling over \$20,000. Grants were awarded to all four public schools in Granby as well as local nonprofits. These grants reached Granby residents of all ages through cultural exploration, inclusion, history, literacy, and the arts.
